using Interactive Videoconferencing.

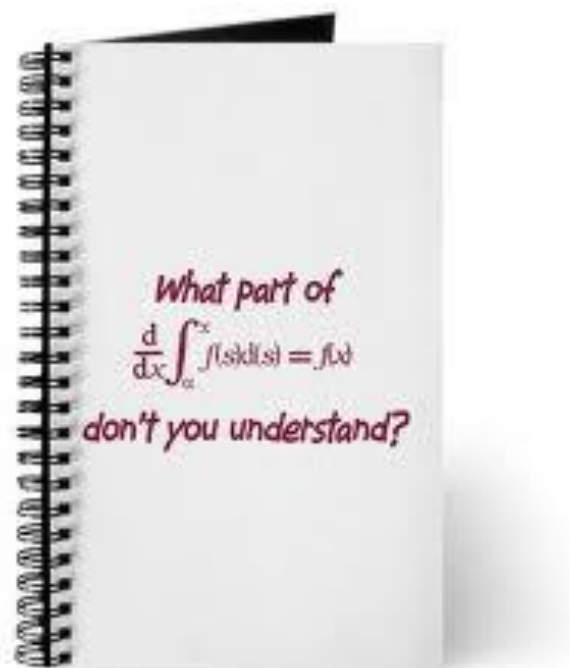
We will all be learning quite a lot this year!
