

# Video Capture with an AVerVision 300AF document camera

turn on button on right side  
Start > Programs > AVerVision > VisionAP

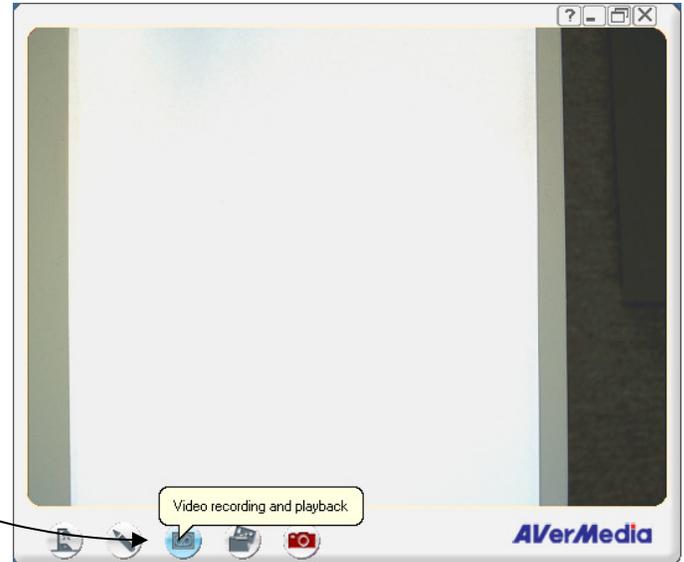
adjust arm, lighting, etc.  
(put a telephone book underneath to gain elevation so  
an entire 8 ½ x 11 page fits)

use a blank sheet of paper to set AWB (Auto White  
Balance)

turn on video capture  
by clicking middle button

(XGA is best)

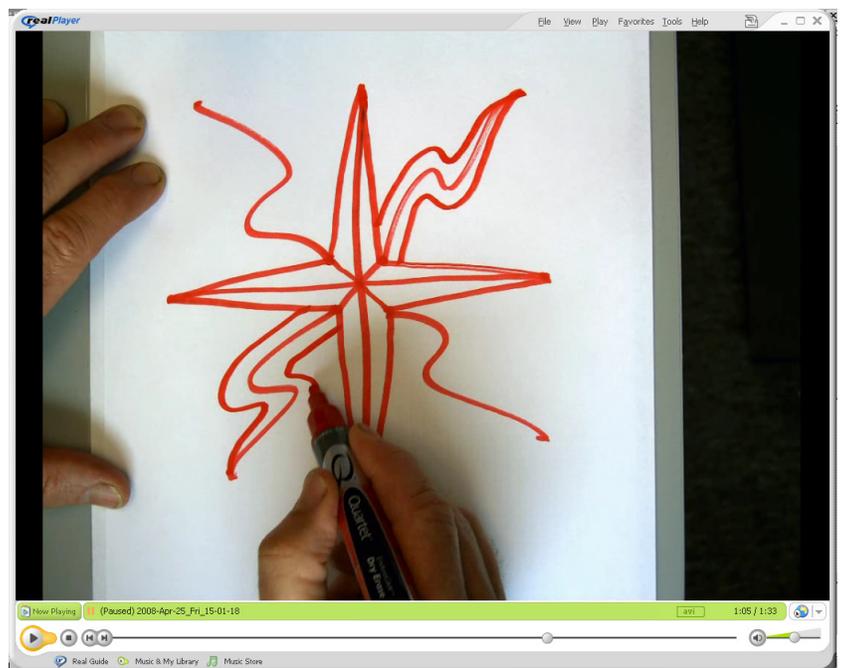
click the little red dot  
to start recording



Hit the Stop button  
when you're done recording

You can record sound at the same time if  
you have a microphone connected. (We  
use a cheap but effective little mic that  
costs about \$5.)

Play back your recording  
and see if you like it
