Are friendly and smiles easily with children in their care			
Are calm and patient when guiding children's behavior			
Help children resolve conflicts			
Allow children to make choices throughout the day			
Encourage language development through conversations			
Help build their confidence by being encouraging

Offers a variety of materials that are visible, organized and within the child's reach			
Displays children's projects and art at their eye level			
Has materials reflect different cultures and genders			
Has safety equipment available including first-aid kits, fire alarms, etc.

Offers planned activities that focus on all areas of development (physical, social, cognitive, language)			
Daily schedule is posted and is flexible to meet the needs of the children
