Please read! Updates on trainings below:

Due to the current Covid-19 outbreak, all in person trainings have been cancelled until further notice. While we have included some training dates for May and June on page 2, these are tentative and subject to cancellation.

We are in the process of exploring how to offer more trainings in a webinar format and will get information to you as those opportunities occur. Please check your email as we will share all training related updates through email. In the meantime, there are webinars scheduled and other online training opportunities shared here. Please know we are trying to figure out how to best support your ongoing education opportunities and training requirements.

CPR Update (per Oregon Early Learning Division Office of Child Care):

If **licensing renewal application** is not timely, for Certified Family/Certified Center, a temporary license will be issued and you will be provided additional time to complete the training. For Registered Family, the license will be issued with additional time to complete the training.

If CPR certifications are expired, online CPR certification is allowed. CCRN is in the process of making hybrid courses available (part online, part in person). Completing the online portion will be sufficient for your renewal. If a hybrid option is not available, you and your staff can select another online option. You will have 60 days from when the state of emergency is lifted to complete the in person skills testing.
