**Emergency Child Care Guidelines-** Currently, child care programs serving children birth- 5 years old are available through the Emergency Child Care Rules. Child care programs who are open must be approved as an ECC. If you are looking for child care during this time please contact 211info.

*Guidance for childcare, summer camps and summer schools now available:*

Governor Brown announced new guidance related to COVID-19 that took effect statewide on May 15. This includes changes related to childcare, summer camps and summer schools. In all counties:

- Childcare is open under certain restrictions, with priority placements for children of health care workers, first responders, and frontline workers.
- Overnight camps are not permitted. Day camps are open with restrictions, including maximum stable groups of 10 or fewer children.
- For summer school, limited in-person, small group instruction and/or summer programming is allowed, with certain restrictions.
- Guidance for childcare providers, summer camps and summer schools to operate safely was issued over the weekend.

**Child Care Reimbursement Guidelines for Foster Parents-** A child care reimbursement through DHS Child Welfare may be authorized for foster parents and relative caregivers with on-going commitments related to full or parttime employment or attending of college or other educational program. In limited circumstances, a supervisor may approve for reasons other than paid employment or education. The child care provider or individual must be approved by your certifier. For more information, please contact your certifier. Reimbursement is up to \$375 per child, per month. Reimbursement is available for children birth-12 years old.

**Alternative Care Funding Guidelines for Foster Parents-** This is additional reimbursement funding to foster parents and relative caregivers for supervision needs due to the COVID-19 stay at home directives. This is alternative funding aside from the Child Care Reimbursement Stipend. A supervisor may approve the use of an alternative care provider and the certified family may be reimbursed for payments made to the approved alternative care provider for the care provided. The provider may include but not limited to respite provider, a child care provider or a babysitter. The maximum amount to be paid is \$375 per child, per month.
