CROSS-SECTOR GROUP WORKING WITH LOCAL LEGISLATORS ON SOUTHERN OREGON AGENDA 2021

Three dozen people from education, public safety, health care, human services and the local business community met with members of our local legislative delegation last month to begin discussions on policy ideas and possible budget requests for the next full session of the Oregon Legislature in 2021.

The meetings are being convened by Southern Oregon Success, along with United Way of Jackson County, Southern Oregon University, Rogue Community College, AllCare, Rogue Workforce Partnership and the Medford/Jackson County Chamber of Commerce.

The goal is to develop a bipartisan, cross-sector agenda that our region's legislators can propose for 2021 and can be supported by multiple organizations and individuals in Southern Oregon. Early discussions include possible ideas on wildfire issues as well as the different areas our region is looking to continue to "go upstream" in working with children, families, schools and communities.
