

Program Year 2020 – 2021 Distance Leaning Model

- 81 Families
- 84 ESL students
- 6 INEA /Pre GED students
- 89 K 8th grade students are receiving online homework support and bi-weekly home packets.
- 27 children ages 3-5 are learning school readiness skills, Zoom story time and bi-weekly home packets.
- 23 children ages 0-2 are participating in early learning activities, bi-weekly home packets and 1:1 weekly support.



2020 – 2021 Program Highlights:



- 89 Latinx families received wraparound services.
- 31 monthly food boxes from the Gleaning Network and distributed by Listo Parent Leadership Team.
- Bi-weekly distribution of 100 age appropriate and culturally specific educational kits.
- 75 iPads lend to families.
- Direct funds distributed to families in response to fire, pandemic and participation incentives.



- Bi-monthly Mental Health and Parental Support Meetings, called Cafecito en Familia by Tatiana Gallardo, LPC.
- 8 families receiving mental health services.
- Provided family internet payment support - November through March.
- 84 Cambridge Ventures books provided to ESL students.
- Pre-GED materials provided to students.



2021 – 2022 Program Plan



- Distance Learning Model Online classes for all age groups.
- Monthly Family Literacy Event called Noche Familiar – Location TBD.
- 100 iPads Loaner Program.
- Provide to families support for home internet payment.
- Hire a Youth Development
 Specialist to offer social emotional support to students K-8th grade.

- Offer Wellness, Mental Health, Educational Training to Parents.
- Parent Leadership and Advocacy Trainings called Padres en Acción.
- Bi-weekly early childhood and ageappropriate hands –on activates.
