### The Beckett Center

- △ 14-bed, Secure Residential Crisis Facility
- △ Sponsored by Jackson County, AllCare, and Jackson Care Connect
- △ For individuals experiencing a mental health crisis
- △ Referrals come from identified agencies in the community
- △ Provides hospital diversion and step-down







# Orchard Home Transitional Housing

- △ 5-bed furnished, Transitional Housing Program
- Sponsored Jackson Care Connect to serve JCC Members
- Suited to be a step-down between The Beckett Center & more permanent, independent housing for those needing ongoing stabilization/lacking housing
- △ Maximum Stay up to 60 days
- △ Staff onsite during business hours, 7 days per week





# East Grove Transitional Housing

- △ 5-bed furnished, Transitional Housing Program
- Sponsored Jackson Care Connect to serve JCC Members
- Suited to be a step-down between The Beckett Center & more permanent, independent housing for those needing ongoing stabilization/lacking housing
- △ Maximum Stay up to 60 days
- △ Staff onsite during business hours, 7 days per week





# Swing Lane Supportive Housing

- △ 11 Total Units Permanent Supportive Housing [5] and Board & Care [6]
- △ Sponsored Jackson Care Connect to serve JCC Members
- △ Awake Staff onsite from 8am-Midnight + 24/7 On-call Emergency
- A Flexible Wrap Around Intensive Case Management, Mental Health Treatment & Habilitative Services





### Rental Assistance Program

RAP is designed to help JCC/AllCare Member who have a Serious Mental Illness to obtain/maintain independent housing in the community. [60 slots]

- △ Individuals who typically face many barriers to obtaining housing.
- Staff (Residential & Peer Support Specialists) assess the tenant's financial resources and, as needed, will provide monetary assistance with application fees, security deposits and other incidentals through state funding for this project.
- Staff provide support from housing search, completing paperwork, connecting utilities, skills-training on being a good tenant and neighbor to maintain housing, housing advocacy

#### Outpatient Services

#### Who We Serve:

- △ Adults
- △ Those with OHP (JCC, AllCare), Medicare, TriWest, and a very small amount of private insurance.

#### Access:

- △ Open access 9:30am-2:00pm, Monday-Friday
- △ Primarily via telehealth from client's home
- △ Clients can come into the clinic and connect via telehealth from our clinic
- △ Pre-COVID we offered two days at Central Clinic and three days at Downtown Clinic
- PCP referrals: We receive referral and reach out to client to arrange access

#### **Services We Provide:**

- △ Therapy
- Case management and skills training
- △ Psychiatric services
- △ Intensive Case Management (ICM)
- △ Supported Employment and Supported Education
- △ On-site pharmacy at Central Clinic
- △ Collaborative partnership with Birch Grove Clinic

Rogue Ridge Apts [2022] Affordable Supportive Housing Complex, includes 23 program-designated units, Resident Mgr unit, and activity room. On-site support services 7 days per week.
