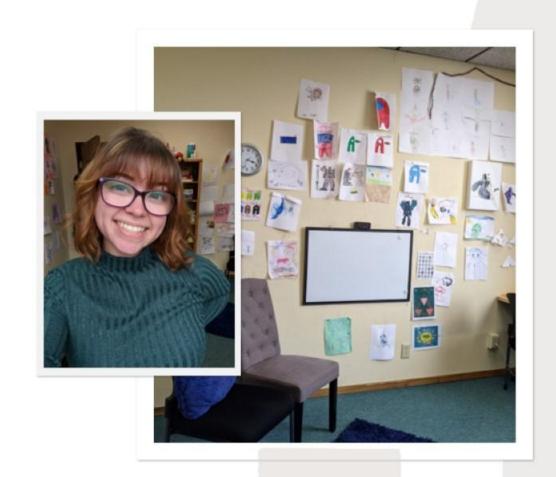

#### OUTPATIENT THERAPY- MEET HAZEL

My clinical orientation is eclectic, meaning that one therapeutic treatment does not fit everyone. I am an LPC Intern receiving supervision regularly and am in the process of becoming a licensed counselor in the state of Oregon.

My preferred age group to work with is children, aged 3-12, but I have experience working with all ages. I really enjoy the creativity that children bring to session, which, in turn, allows me to be creative. I have found that having a "toolbox" filled with evidence-based techniques is necessary, but allowing the client to experiment, be creative, and move during session has proven the most helpful with making progress stick.

I believe having the family system involved in treatment allows the client the best chance of making significant progress, as I see the client once per week, while the family sees them every day.





### OUTPATIENT THERAPY— MEET MARIA

My practice is built around the Acceptance and Commitment Therapy style, focusing on mindfulness and the development of practical skills that will assist my clients in addressing their mental health concerns. I support this with an openness to the individual experience, as well as an awareness of the true need for individuals in the adolescent age group to explore and define healthy practices that will support them as they transition into adulthood.

As a Native American woman, I am also familiar with the challenges to minorities and women in our larger society and am empathetic with the need for cultural sensitivity. I have personal and professional experiences that tie me to the LGBTQ+ community, and these reinforce my efforts to be an advocate and ally both in and out of the therapy office.

### OUTPATIENT THERAPY-MEET VANESSA

My objective as a Skills Trainer is to appreciate and support each client's individuality and unique characteristics. I create lessons tailored to the individual to assist each client with their specific needs. In formulating goals for our clients, I collaborate with therapists and case managers to implement strategies and achieve these goals.

I utilize a range of evidence-based techniques to help clients manage struggles with anger/aggression, anxiety, conduct disorders, social skills, emotional regulation, problem solving, control, depression, trauma, self-esteem and many others.

I enjoy turning Skills Training into a game or art project, which helps my clients retain and use these skills in their daily lives. I work with all ages of youth and hold sessions in my office, in the school or in the home.

### DAY TREATMENT

Children attend day treatment in place of public school with a typical treatment duration of approximately 9-12 months.

#### Services Include:

- Assessment and evaluation
- ➤ Individualized special and regular education
- Daily milieu therapy with an emphasis on social skill building
- ➤ Individual and family therapy
- > Psychiatric consultation
- ➤ Individual and group skills training
- Case management

#### PROCTOR CARE

Proctor Care/Foster Plus is a form of foster care which empowers families with the training and support needed to address trauma, cultivate a therapeutic environment, and create opportunities for healing.

- ✓ 24/7 Crisis Support
- ✓ Respite/Relief Care for families providing fulltime care
- ✓ Proctor Foster families are provided with rigorous and on-going training specific to the needs of the youth in their care

#### Who we Serve

- Oregon foster youth who have struggled to thrive in traditional foster care settings because of emotional or behavioral challenges
- Ages 4-18
- Goal: Stabilize, address trauma, build skills, prevent higher level of care



### RESIDENTIAL

Family Solutions residential programs were developed to create a structured and supportive home for youth who have not been successful in foster care, proctor foster care, or other residential programs.

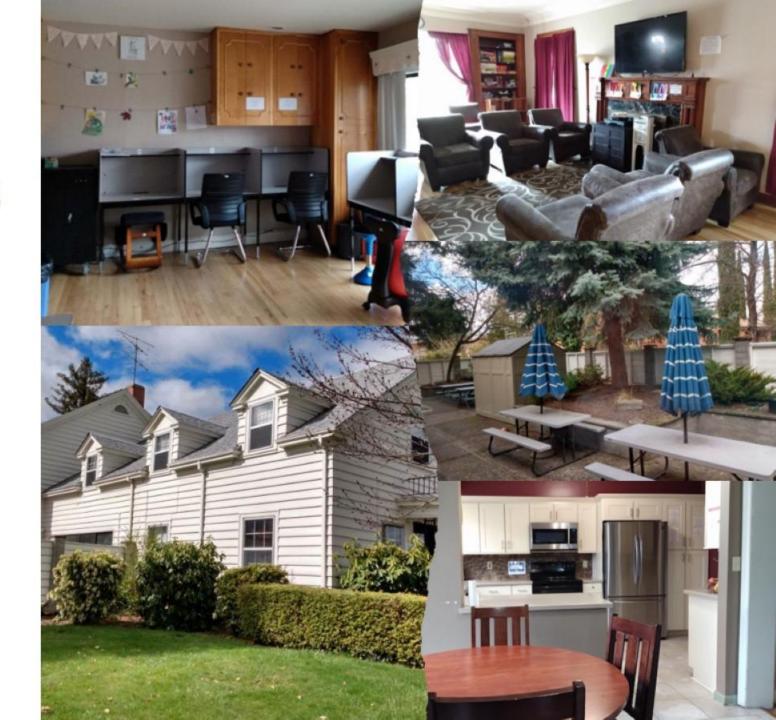
The therapeutic milieu of the residential homes focuses on the psychosocial, emotional and familial issues that have led to problematic and/or self-destructive behaviors by the person served.

The goal upon discharge is primarily to place the person served in a less restrictive setting (for example: home of origin, adoptive home, proctor care, or emancipation).

- > Average length of stay is 9-12 months
- > Referrals are made to the program through centralized referral process

- Serving ages 12-20
