### DELIC: Department of Early Learning and Care Update:

Oregon's child care systems came together under the new Department of Early Learning and Care (DELIC) on July 1, 2023. Over the next few years, DELIC will create more efficient systems to help families access child care, and better serve children across the state. All child care and early learning programs in Oregon, including the Employment Related Day Care program, will be run by DELIC. This will not change the way families get ERDC benefits.
