DELIC: Department of Early Learning and Care Update:

[Click here](#) for the latest update from DELIC, including information on the 2024 Legislative Session Report. In February 2024, the Oregon Legislature convened for a short 32-day session. As a Governor-led executive branch agency, the Department of Early Learning and Care (DELIC) did not take a position on any legislative proposals. However, DELIC had a number of important budget items up for consideration, and the legislature made critical investments that support the agency's mission to foster coordinated, culturally appropriate, and family-centered services that recognize and respect the strengths and needs of all children, families, and early learning and care professionals.
